

2019 Pit 5 Reach Whitewater Flows

August 10–11 and September 14–15

Flows will be 1,200 to 1,500 cfs or more



This river reach contains class III, IV, and V rapids appropriate only for skilled whitewater paddlers. Reach is not appropriate for tubing at these flows.

As required by the Pit 3, 4, 5 Project Hydroelectric license, PG&E will be releasing high, whitewater flows from the **Pit 5 Dam to the J.B. Black Powerhouse.**

Cold, Swift Water

Sudden immersion in cold water can stimulate the “gasp reflex” causing an involuntary inhalation of air or water.

Wear a Life Vest and Know Your Limits

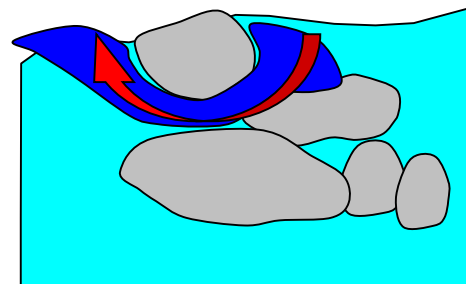
Swift flows can create treacherous currents and drowning risks for anglers, waders, swimmers, and boaters.
